Thank you for considering membership in the Waikiki Yacht Club, "The Premier Yacht Club of the Pacific."

The following steps outline the application process:

- 1. Read *Part A Side-by-Side Comparisons* of the attached application package
 - a. Per Waikiki Yacht Club's (the Club's) bylaws, two sponsors are needed to complete your application (Youth Membership only requires one sponsor). If you need assistance with sponsorship, please inquire with the Club office personnel.
 - b. Please either attach a current, waist to top-of-head photo or have a photo taken on the date of your interview (face picture will be published in the Windward Beat).
 - c. Attach the initiation fee appropriate to your chosen membership category. Make the check payable to: Waikiki Yacht Club. (*NOTE: Joint membership applicants must provide a copy of their marriage certificate.*)
- 2. Deliver your *Part B Application for Membership*, current photo, and initiation fee to the Club office.
- 3. Then complete the following portions of the membership packet prior to the interview:

- 4. Your completed *Part B* will be given to the Membership Committee for review and processing, which will include posting notice of your application for membership at the Club and scheduling an interview with the Membership Committee.
- 5. The Membership Committee will make a recommendation regarding your application to the Board. Acceptance of your application is subject to Board approval.
- 6. If approved by the Board, applicants will be notified of their acceptance and advised when their new members packets will be ready at the Club office for pick-up.

NOTE A: An associate membership is an individual membership. (WYC Bylaws 2.3, House Rules 2.1.2.(a))

NOTE B: Active duty military members are required to convert to regular or another class of membership for which they are eligible after leaving service.

NOTE C: Upon an intermediate member's 35th birthday, he or she is required to upgrade to another class of membership for which the member is eligible.

NOTE D: At age 21 each youth member shall automatically become an intermediate member *without the* requirement to submit an application or pay an initiation fee.

NOTE E: Non-resident members are entitled to use the Club for up to 60 days per calendar year. Physical presence on O'ahu for more than 4 months (121 days) per calendar year shall constitute residency and preclude this class of membership.

NOTE F: Joint Rights mean the ability for a spouse to jointly hold membership at WYC; however, only one of them holds the privileges associated with that membership class.
